



- Classes are divided into 2 Sections with small class sizes to ensure that students are given enough attention in their Online Classes:





SYNCHRONOUS CLASSES

- Online Lessons with teachers and Classmates Interacting in Real-Time.
- Held using Google Meet in the Google Classroom.
- 40-minute class per Subject for Primary and 50-minute Class per Subject for Intermediate and High School.
- Synchronous Classes is held twice a week: (Mondays and Tuesdays for Section A; Thursdays and Fridays for Section B).
- 10-minute Breaks in Between to properly space Screen Time.



Google Meet

is a video-chatting service designed primarily for business and office use, which lets colleagues chat over video and text.

Google Workspace for Education

a free suite of easy-to-use tools that provide a flexible and secure foundation for learning, collaboration, and communication.

is an educational technology company offering a web-based application to K-12 schools and teachers.



Nearpod


is an online tool that allows teachers to use slide-based teaching both in the classroom and remotely thanks to a hybrid layout.

is an online assessment tool that allows to teachers and students to create and use one another's quizzes.

MODES OF DELIVERY







ASYNCHRONOUS CLASSES

Self-directed Online and Offline activities designed in a learning module to supplement and support classes.

Learning Modules contain learning objectives, learning tasks and Post-task Assessment.

Students work independently on the learning modules assigned for the day.

- They may work on them in any order but has to submit Post-task assessments before the due time and date as scheduled by the teacher.
- Teachers are available for consultation at specified hours during Asynchronous class days.
- Asynchronous classes are held twice a week: Thursdays and Fridays for Section A; Mondays and Tuesdays for Section B.



Google Classroom

a suite of online tools that allows teachers to set assignments, have work submitted by students, to mark, and to return graded papers.

Google Workspace for Education

Google Workspace

a free suite of easy-to-use tools that provide a flexible and secure foundation for learning, collaboration, and communication.



Flipgrid

is a video tool that allows teachers to post "Topics" that are essentially videos with some accompanying text.



Ed Puzzle

is a teaching tool used to place interactive content into pre-existing videos from a variety of sources, such as TED or YouTube, or into videos you have made.




Codecademy

is an online interactive platform that offers free coding classes in 12 different programming languages.

PAREF WESTBRIDGE

PERSONAL FORMATION PROGRAM

The Personal Formation Programs of the school will continue amidst the current situation of Quarantine and Social Distancing protocols. These programs will run not due to the restrictions but precisely because of the current conditions and needs that the pandemic has brought about for everyone.



PROGRAM 01

MENTORING CHATS WITH STUDENTS

At the beginning of the school year, parents will be asked to sign a consent form allowing their sons to have one-on-one online chats with their mentors with indicated provisions for the protection of the privacy of both the mentee and the mentor. The platform for mentoring chats with students will be Google Meet. The chat should only be conducted within weekday office hours (i.e., no chats beyond 5:00 PM from Monday to Friday). However, mentees or their parents can get in touch with their mentors or the Guidance Office in case of emergencies. Unlike in the traditional set-up where students can be pulled out of their classrooms during a class for a chat, mentors cannot schedule chats that will conflict with the online synchronous classes of their mentees.

PROGRAM 02

MENTORING CHATS WITH PARENTS

Similar to the student set-up, the mentors will conduct their chats for the first two quarters of the school year online. Mentors and parents can make use of any communication medium (e.g., email, SMS, social media, etc.) to coordinate among themselves the scheduling of their chat anytime during the mentors' office hours. Likewise, enough time should be given to either the mentor or the mentee's parents to adjust for any rescheduling of chats. Google Meet will be the recommended platform for chats with parents, though parents may request to use their preferred platform (e.g., Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Messenger, Viber, etc.).





SCHOOL FOR PARENTS

The School has registered as an Institution to the Franciscan University of Steubenville Online Platform of Formative Talks, Seminars, Conventions, Workshops and Courses. All Westbridge Teachers and Parents may register using the school's registered domain in order to avail of these Online Formative resources (https://franciscanathome.com/#institutions). Parents may do this at their own convenience, but the Personal Formation Department may schedule some of these Talks in the Parents Forum section of our website to promote a collective effort to learn from a distinguished speaker.



EDU CHILD PRORGRAMS FOR PARENTS

The EDUCHILD Programs for Parents promoted by Westbridge such as the New Parents Educational Program (NPEP), the Middle Childhood Parents Course (MCPC) and the Parenting Teens will be scheduled Online or In-Person during the School Year, depending of the availability of the Educhild Speakers and its moderators and facilitators. Announcements on the schedule of these sessions will be posted in your son's Google Classrooms as well as in the school's Website and Facebook Page.



MONTHLY STUDENT ASSEMBLY

The monthly student assembly will be done ONLINE via Facebook Live on the First Wednesday of the Month from 10:00 – 11:00 am. Students may attend these assemblies through the Google Meet where the live or pre-recorded coverage of the speaker is shared by the Class Adviser. During the monthly student assembly, Talks on the Virtue of the Month, a Talk by an invited speaker on Current or Special Issues and official announcements regarding upcoming school activities are discussed.



CHAPLAINCY SEVICES

The School Chaplain will be celebrating Holy Mass at the School Chapel observing the minimum health protocols. This will be live streamed on our Facebook Page for students and parents to attend. The Chaplain's Corner in our FB Page will be posting a schedule of other activities in the school like the Online Recollections for Professional Men and Online Retreats, which will be available through Zoom or Facebook Live.

A desktop (with Webcam and Microphone) or a laptop computer with internet connection can support the demands of Online Learning. A headset with microphone is recommended for Synchronous Classes but earphones with built-in microphones may suffice.

Tablets will also be functional for Online Learning. When paired with a Bluetooth keyboard, they can easily substitute for a desktop or laptop.

Other devices, such as Smart Phones are not recommended for prolonged periods of online classes due to the difficulty to navigate online materials.

A Fiber Internet Connection of at least 10 mbps is ideal for Online Learning especially during Synchronous Classes. However, a pocket wifi with an LTE or 4G connection will also work fine.

While not absolutely required, a printer for printing reading materials and activity sheets can also be helpful for those who opt to complete activities offscreen as much as possible.

ONLINE CLASS

CODE OF CONDUCT

PAREF-Westbridge students are expected to have self-discipline especially during this time of Online-learning. It is through their practice of this virtue and the guidance of their teachers that they will be able to learn effectively and efficiently.

Appropriate and desirable conduct are expected to be observed during online classes.




Students should wear a collared shirt or the regular Westbridge white or green polo shirt.

GROOMING

Students should be cleanly shaven and should sport the prescribed haircut. It should not touch the back collar of the polo shirt, the upper portion of the ear, and the eyebrows. However, if a student is not able to get a haircut because of quarantine restrictions, he must fix his hair for him to look presentable at all times.

PLACE OF STUDY

Students are highly encouraged to have a clean and orderly workspace and background.







All students and teachers participating in online classes are expected to conduct their communications in a professional and respectful manner. The use of proper internet etiquette is expected at all times. Inappropriate conduct or behavior will be subject to disciplinary action. Policies and procedures outlined in the Student Handbook will also apply to all online classes. Therefore, the violation of any of these netiquettes may result in a student being suspended from attending his online classes and running the risk of missing academic work.

- Students must abide by rules, procedures and policies established by the subject teacher.
- 2 Students must be polite and courteous both in written and oral communications, especially in Google Meet.
- Communications must be free of vulgarity, belittling, offensive language, and any other forms of bullying.
- Students must respect the personal information and privacy of their teachers and classmates.
- Students must participate actively in all learning sessions.
- 6 Students must complete all assignments and work in a timely and thorough manner.
- 7 Students must not commit any act of computer vandalism e.g. online hacking that causes damage to the good name of the school, school property, and servers.
- Students must not misrepresent an identity or assume the identity of another by using login credentials other than those specifically assigned. This includes using email or login information issued to another including family members.

PARENTAL/GUARDIAN SUPERVISION

or Support for Online Classes For Online Classes, parents/guardians are expected:

- To study the school's weekly learning plan to (for grade school) organize a schedule for their son or (for high school) to encourage him to create a schedule that balances work and rest.
- To prepare a conducive workspace for their son with the materials and equipment needed, including a device needed for online check-ins and accessing materials.
- Set rules during school hours that are conducive to study and intense work.
- As necessary (especially for students in the lower grades), to help their son access Google Classroom and other online tools.
- To remind or ensure that their son attends scheduled check-ins and synchronous sessions.
- Using the subject syllabi and module checklists, to regularly monitor their son's progress in completing his academic tasks and help him stay motivated to do his work without resorting to external incentives or penalties.
- 7 At intervals, to help process their son's learning experiences, difficulties and challenges.
- 8 To encourage their son to attend synchronous sessions, take advantage of his teachers' work hours to consult and clarify, and to do his independent work thoroughly and in a timely manner.
- In the higher grades, to allow their son the discretion and independence he needs to become more fully responsible for his own learning.
- The scheduled orientation and simulation sessions for parents and guardians so they can better assist their children in effectively adapting to the Online Learning set-up will be during the first two weeks of School Year 2021 2022
